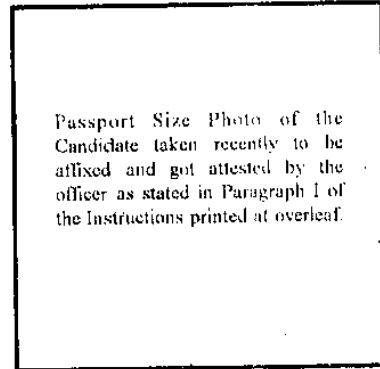

Candidate should note the following Instructions carefully and adhere strictly.

1. The Candidate should put his/her signature in the space provided in this Hall-Ticket in the presence of a responsible person preferably a Gazetted Officer or The Principal the Headmaster/Headmistress of a T.T.I. High School/Higher Secondary School or Tahsildar or a Deputy Tahsildar or a Panchayat Union Commissioner, etc., who will attest the signature and photo of the candidate as an identification on the Hall Ticket itself. The candidate should also sign in the Hall-Ticket in the examination centre before the Chief or Assistant Superintendent on all the days of attendance of the Examination.
2. The candidate should write his/her name in block capitals and date of birth in the column provided in the Hall-Ticket as found in the Record book, etc., besides noting his/her residential address with Pin Code.
3. The photo should be properly pasted in the space provided and it should not be pinned, *since the Hall-Ticket without photo is not valid.*
4. This Hall-Ticket should be produced at the examination centre shown to the Chief Superintendent whenever demanded and surrendered to the Chief Superintendent on the final day of the examination.
5. Hall-Ticket will be sent by Post to the Candidates to their residential addresses ten days before the commencement of the examination.

INSTRUCTIONS.

1. This application should be used only by the candidates who have undergone Diploma Course in Teacher Education for two years and failed in the examination. They should submit their applications directly to this office. APPLICATIONS NEED NOT BE SENT through the Teacher Training Institutes.
2. Candidate should furnish the particulars in the application correctly taking all precautions since wrong particulars will lead to unnecessary correspondence.
3. The Centre selected should be one of the centres in the list given below, and it should also be the nearest one to their residential address. No change in the centre selected will be allowed later.

Hall Tickets will be issued to the Regular Private candidates (ex-students) and they will be despatched, from this Office to their addresses given in their applications ten days before the commencement of the examination. They have to produce the Hall Tickets at the examination hall on all the days of the examination.
 8. Full postal address should be furnished. All communications to the candidates from this Office will be sent to the address given in column (10) of the application. Requests from candidates to note the change in their address *will not be attended to*. They should write to the Post-Master concerned to redirect all letters from this office to their correct address.
 9. Candidates should clearly mention the subjects in which they desire to be examined.
 10. The previous appearance Register number session and year in which the candidate appeared for the Diploma Examination should be mentioned correctly against column (6) in the Computer Coding Sheet. If no previous year Register number is furnished by the candidate, he will be asked to appear for all the subjects of the examination, his success or failure being determined on the result of the examination for which he appeared last.
 11. The medium through which the question papers will be answered should invariably be specified against column (7) in the Computer Coding sheet. In the absence of such specification it will be assumed that the medium for answering is *Tamil*. Change of medium or subject from that already made in application will not ordinarily be permitted.
 12. In submitting an application for admission to the examination, the candidate will be deemed to have given an undertaking that he will abide by all the rules now in force or those to be brought into effect here after in respect of that examination including the following : No revaluation of answer paper is permissible and no notice will be taken of any communication asking for information as to the cause of failure.
 13. Any candidate who communicates with the examiners or who does not behave properly towards the Chief and Assistant Superintendents of the examination or is suspected of having had recourse to malpractice of any kind in connection with the examination, or whose answer paper contains objectionable matter is liable to have his examination invalidated and also to be debarred from appearing again for the examination for such terms of years at the Director of Government Examinations may think fit, or if the Director is not satisfied for any reason what so ever, as to the trust worthiness of his results, his result may be cancelled or he may be required to undergo re-examination at some future date to be fixed by the Director in any one or more of the subjects of the examination, for which he appeared his success or failure being determined on the result of such re-examination.
 14. *The fee paid will not be refunded under any circumstances nor will it be reserved for a subsequent examination. Candidates are warned to study the notification carefully and satisfy themselves before remitting their fees that they fulfil the prescribed conditions of admission to the examination.*
 15. Candidates who gain admission by producing false information, will have their examination invalidated, and further disciplinary action will also be taken against them.
