ORDER:

As at present, the minimum age-limit for non-pupil private candidates for writing S.S.L.C. and Higher Secondary Examinations is 14/2 and 16/2 years respectively from 1991-92. The non-pupil private candidates are permitted to appear privately for +2 Examination after a lapse of a period varying from 6 to 18 months after passive 10th Standard examination. However, the students who undergo the regular course of study in a school has to put in 10 years of study to complete X Standard and a further 2 years of study to complete this plus two course (Higher Secondary Course). As there is no minimate the period of S.S.L.C. and Higher Secondary Examination for the candidates who go through the school in +1 and +2 and appears the examination. This has resulted in resentment among regular students as this affects their prospects.

- 2. The Madras University has imposed a stipulation whereby after private study, persons who have passed Higher Secondary Englination could be admitted to the degree course, only after a of two years after passing the 10th Standard examination irrespond to the date of passing the +2 examination. The Government have examined this with Director of School Education and Director of Government Examinations. They have concurred with the above stipulation of Madras University and have requested for orders.
- 3. The Government accept the recommendations of Director of School Education and Director of Government Examinations and direct that emong the other conditions for admission of candidates to appear privately for the Higher Secondary Examinations, the following condition is added:

"Only those candidates who have completed the age of 1672 (with reference to G.O. Ms.No.192 Education, dated 25.2.192) years (as on 1st April for March/April Session and 1st October for September/October Session) and who have the minimum of two years gap from the

year of passing of X Standard examination are eligible to appear privately for the Higher Secondary Examination with effect from March/ April 1993 Examinations".
